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1 | 8 Lower Saxony's Minister President Stephan Weil (l., SPD) visiting Norbert Borner, Managing Director of textile manufacturer Zender Germany GmbH.

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2 | 8 Osnabrück-based automotive supplier and textile processing expert Zender has temporarily switched its production.

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3 | 8 Instead of textiles for vehicle production, it has started producing FFP2-certified protective masks.

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4 | 8 This is to meet the increased demand for protective masks for clinics and medical practices in the COVID-19 crisis.

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5 | 8 At the moment, protective clothing and respiratory masks have to be procured on the global market. However, demand far exceeds supply.

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6 | 8 Weil takes a look at the textile manufacturer's production plant. The Federal Government wants to support companies that are adapting their production to medical goods.

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7 | 8 At present, Zender produces around 50,000 certified face masks per day.

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8 | 8 Soon, 100,000 masks for medical use will be produced here daily.
